Context

The Cairnmillar Institute (the Institute) is a private, community-based provider of psychological services. The organisation is an independent, Not-For-Profit Company and a Health Promotion Charity. Cairnmillar provides psychological treatment services, higher education psychology and counselling training, and short courses.

Sustainability can be defined as any efforts to protect the (work) environment. These efforts take place on different levels such as environmental, organisational/administrative/structural, cultural and concerning our so called `social business`.

Cairnmillar strives to utilize all available resources carefully and responsibly.

Purpose of the policy

The purpose of sustainability management means that future generations will enjoy environmental, social and economic conditions that are equal to or better than those enjoyed by the present generation.

The Institute's Council recognises its moral and legal responsibility to provide and keep good environmental, social and economic conditions for all employees, students, contractors, clients and visitors. This needs to be valid for the future work environment not less than the current one.

Scope

All Institute employees, students, volunteers, contractors and visitors.

Procedures

In order to manage our sustainability policy Cairnmillar has established as sustainability committee. The purpose of the Committee is to initiate, implement and monitor environmentally sustainable activities.

The sustainability committee will provide a report quarterly to the Executive of Cairnmillar. In turn the Executive will provide the Cairnmillar council any significant feedback
